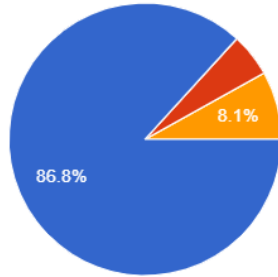


January 2023 Asking Our Parents

The funds were raised to support school events, school meals, and our Fine Arts program. Is the current level of fundraising appropriate at FLVT?

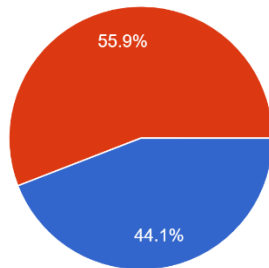

Our bell times are influenced by transportation. If there is a change to our bus schedule, and if we have any input, which option would you prefer?

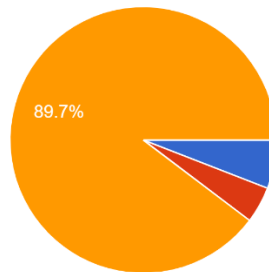

School Communication - Please click on the best response.

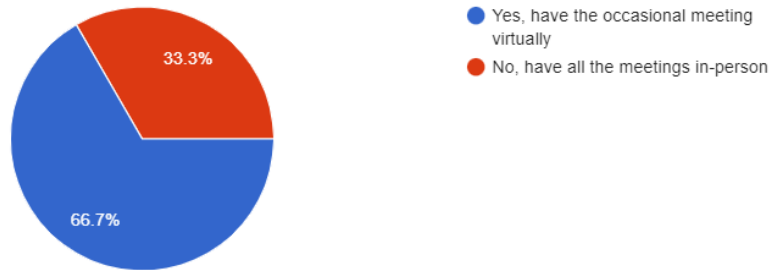

- I'm happy with the current level of school communication.

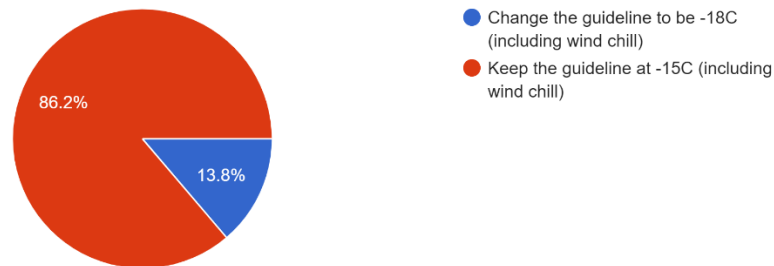

Our division has moved to a 3:1 ratio for technology (3 students to one device) as a base level for all schools. FLVT will be allotted 200 devices.
